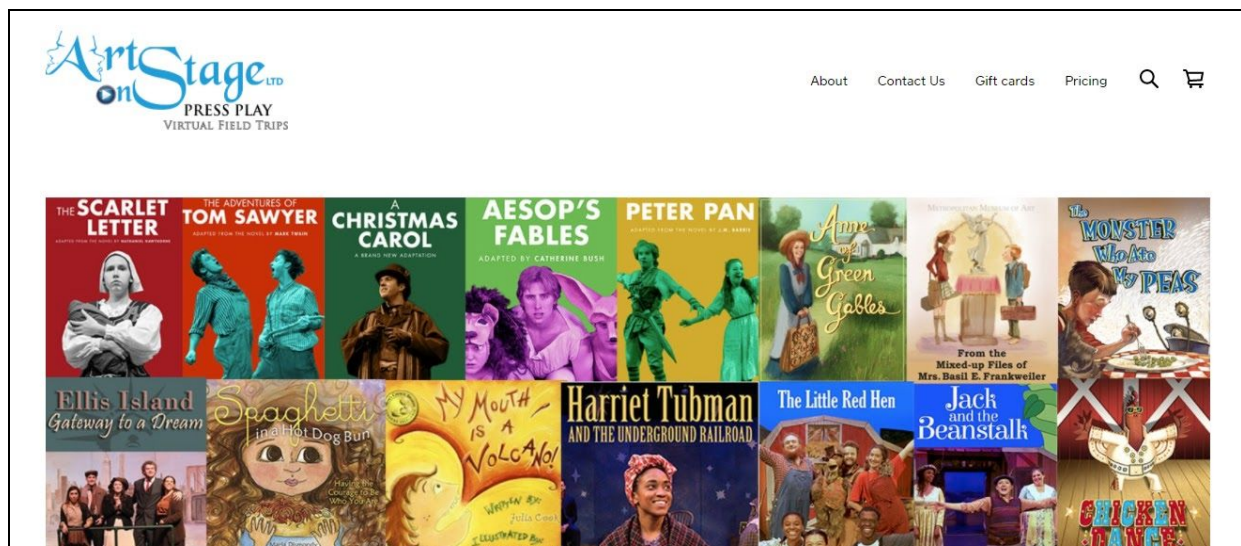


FAQ -- Virtual Field Trip FAMILY Edition

1). How do I purchase a virtual field trip?

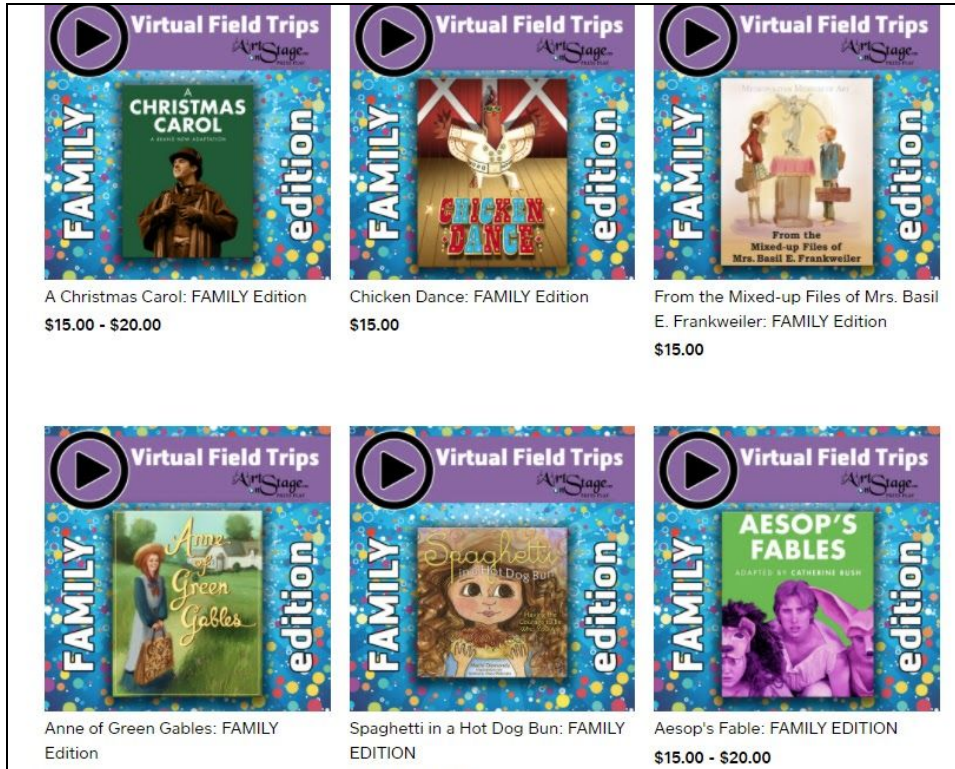
Step 1- Go to website, <https://artsonstage-pressplay.square.site/>



Step 2- Click on Family Edition image

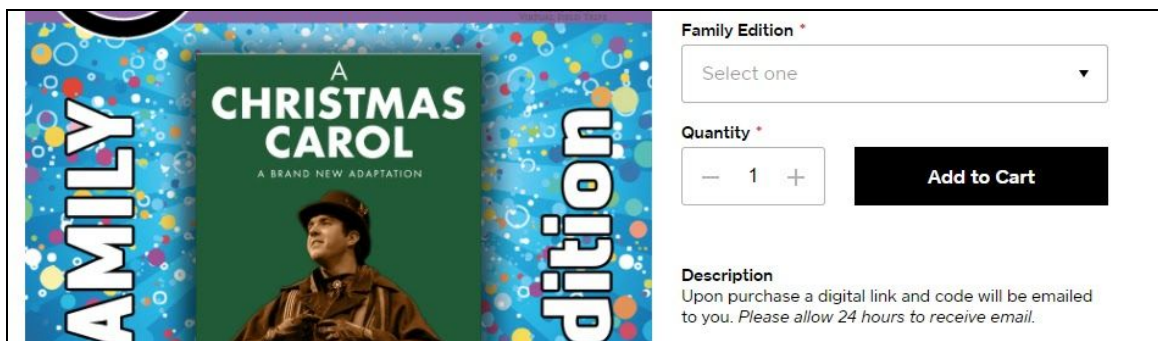
