



1). How do I purchase a virtual field trip?


Step 1- Go to website, <https://artsonstage-pressplay.square.site/>



Step 2- Click on School Edition image



Step 3 - Click on the show that you are interested in (**there are more titles than what is shown below.**) There you will find a short synopsis of what's included with the purchase of your Virtual field trip.



Step 4 - **If you need an Invoice** because you are paying with a PO, Third Party, or needed for approval purposes, please click on “Contact Us” in the upper right hand corner of the website. Let me know what school you are from and what Virtual Field Trips you are interested in and how you will be paying.

Step 5 - If you are ready to pay with a credit card, click “Add to cart”.
