“FINDING THE BALANCE” MOBILE MAKING WORKSHOPS PRESENTED BY ARTS ON STAGE

One-day Residency (up to 5, one hour, workshops per day) for Students K thru 6th

Kevin Reese introduces students to the art of moving sculptures (mobiles) and their key design element -- balance. Working in groups of 4, students each make 1-2 pieces for a mobile from classroom art supplies and materials provided by Kevin. Students work cooperatively to solve how to balance the pieces as they assemble their mobiles. Students also help design, measure, cut, sand, paint and assemble the sculpture, giving them a hands-on experience of the creative process and a tremendous sense of ownership in the result. The mobiles are then installed in the classroom for all to enjoy.

- Recommended Class size of 30 students per workshop
- Up to 5 workshops per day
- Mobiles are approximately 3 feet across when complete
- Participation of 2-3 adults is helpful for younger grades
- One-day Workshop Residency cost is \$1,400
- For larger schools: Two-day Workshop is \$2,800; Three-day is \$3,600; Four-day is \$4,400; Five-day is \$5,000
- Curriculum Connections are Language Arts, Visual Arts, Math and Science

**Arts On Stage will be presenting the Theatrical Show “A Perfect Balance” on May 1, 2012 at Goucher College. The Workshops will complement the Show, allow students to make connections and be able to ask Kevin questions while working. It is recommended for students to see the show first, but is not required.*
